Cost share funds for private forest landowners are available through the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation's Longleaf Landscape Stewardship Fund.

FLA will provide cost share at \$50 per acre for establishing new stands of longleaf pine, including site preparation and planting. FLA will provide cost share at \$15 per acre for management of existing longleaf pine stands, with priority given to prescribed burning projects.
