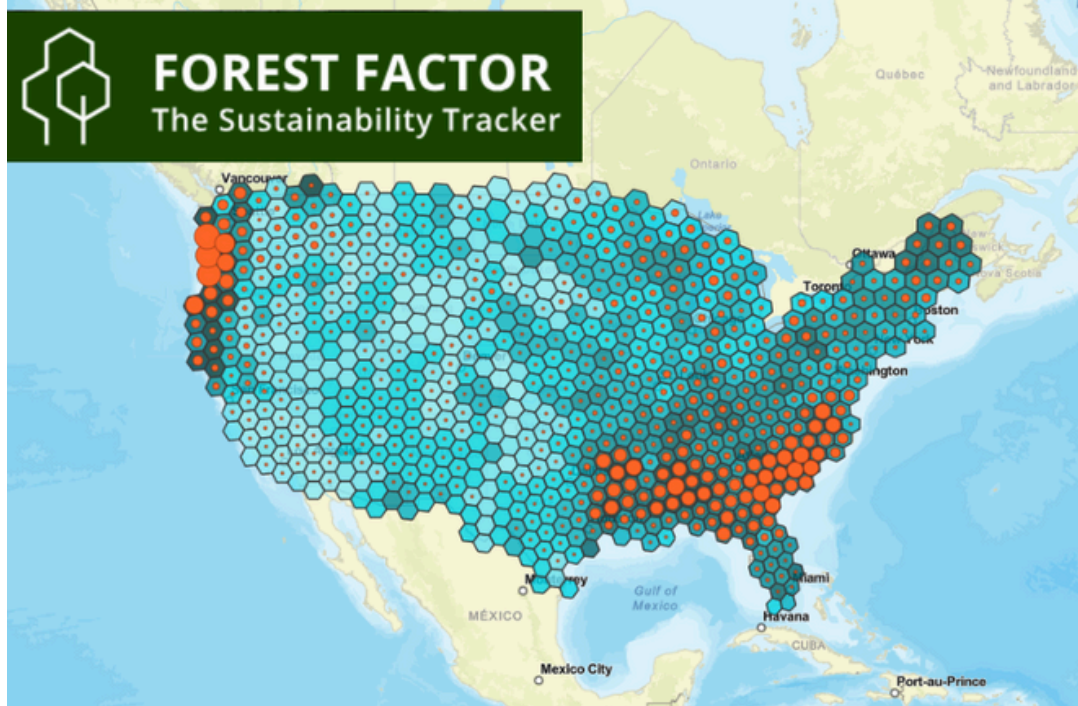

Timber Markets

While not part of the sustainability score, timber harvest and market activity are visible in Forest Factor as a key reference layer. **Strong markets lead to better management**—providing landowners with the incentive and resources to keep forests healthy, productive, and permanently forested. When sustainably managed, forests are a renewable resource with lasting environmental and economic benefits.

How to Use Forest Factor

1. Visit www.forestfactor.org
2. Click "Explorer"
3. Choose a Location by clicking on a hexagon
4. Zoom or search for a state or county or put your zip code into the "search" bar
5. View the sustainability score (1-7)
6. Click any of the six tabs to explore sustainability metrics and how they contribute
7. Customize Your View with filters, legends, and map layers—including the Timber Harvest layer—for deeper insight.

- Promote strong timber markets and landowner incentives
