Dear President Trump:

We write on behalf of private forest landowners, forestry agencies, loggers, businesses, and associations from across the nation, collectively representing a sector that supports 3.9 million American jobs. We want to draw your attention to a growing national security crisis that threatens the nation's timber supply, rural economies, and long-term energy independence. With the right policies, however, your Administration can not only stabilize these challenges but also spark new job creation, strengthen domestic manufacturing, and drive economic growth in rural America.

On March 1st, you signed an Executive Order directing federal agencies to boost the domestic production of timber and wood products—a clear recognition that working forests are critical to our economic resilience, housing supply, consumer products, energy production, and national security. Today, that directive faces unprecedented headwinds.

Hurricane Helene inflicted significant timber losses in several southern states, including \$1.28 billion in losses in Georgia alone. Moreover, the recent closure of two mills in Savannah and Riceboro, Georgia, has eliminated nearly 1,100 jobs and destabilized the very heart of the forestry value chain in those communities. These blows are the latest in an alarming national trend: since 2014, more than 31 pulp and paper mills have closed across the country, removing at least 42 million tons of pulpwood demand and \$20.9 billion in sales and manufacturing from the U.S. timber economy. This is leaving communities across America without markets, jobs, or the certainty needed to keep forests in forests.

The challenges confronting America's forests are escalating nationwide:

- **Natural disasters**—including hurricanes, wildfires, tornadoes, ice storms, and floods—destroy millions of acres of timber each year.
- **Pests and diseases**—such as the Southern pine beetle infestations, spruce budworm outbreaks, sudden oak death, and other pests and pathogens—are devastating entire stands of timber.
- **Mill closures** nationwide are stripping markets from landowners and rural workers, leaving them without outlets for their timber.
- Unfair foreign trade practices are undercutting U.S. producers and distorting global markets, eroding our ability to compete.

Together, these forces are pushing many landowners to exit forestry altogether. If forests are abandoned or converted, the consequences for our domestic timber supply, as well as markets for housing, infrastructure, consumer products, energy, rural livelihoods, and environmental security, will be severe. This is not just a regional concern—it is a national crisis. Strong working forests are important to America's overall economic strength. But with decisive action, we can turn these threats into opportunities—keeping landowners on the land, supporting loggers and mill workers, and creating new jobs through expanded markets for wood products, renewable energy, and bio-based manufacturing.

There are four immediate steps your Administration can take to support the goals of your March 1st order by removing impediments, providing certainty to landowners and communities, and sparking job creation and economic growth:

- 1. Endorse and Support the Disaster Reforestation Act—Allow landowners to deduct their timber lost to natural disasters, so they can replant and keep forests as forests after events like Helene and catastrophic wildfires—protecting rural livelihoods and ensuring forestry continues to be a source of jobs and economic vitality.
- 2. Expand the definition of qualifying woody biomass in the Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS)—Clarifying and expanding the definition of woody biomass in the RFS so that small trees, harvest residuals, and mill residuals can be made into transportation fuel for aviation, shipping, and other applications, would open new markets for low-value wood, help wildfire prevention, improve forest health, and strengthen rural economies while increasing American energy production and creating new jobs.
- **3. Promote biomass for electricity** Promoting biomass for electricity production to power homes and manufacturing would rapidly contribute to wildfire risk reduction and support the wood product supply chain, while generating new employment in power production and mill communities. In addition, expanding the use of biomass would create new market opportunities for other agricultural products and residues, further strengthening rural economies and supporting America's farmers alongside forest landowners.
- **4. Support the Loggers Economic Assistance Act**—Ensuring that logging contractors, who are vital to harvesting and transporting timber, have access to direct relief and economic assistance will stabilize the entire forestry value chain and preserve thousands of logging jobs that are essential for moving timber to market, while supporting broader growth in rural economies.

Mr. President, America's private forests are a strategic asset. They provide raw materials for housing, infrastructure, consumer products, and renewable energy, while supporting millions of jobs. Without decisive action, we risk losing this foundation of our economy and national security. By advancing these measures, your Administration can ensure not only that America's forests remain strong and resilient, but also that they continue to be engines of job creation, economic growth, and prosperity in the rural communities that form the backbone of this nation.
